

Green Up Poster and Writing Projects

Green Up Day, first Saturday in May, when thousands of Vermonters of all ages continue to come together annually in their communities to clean up and give our lovely state its "spring cleaning."

The student **poster design project** has long been important in Vermont's unique Green Up tradition. One design is selected as the overall winner and printed in full color for distribution statewide to promote Green Up Day. The designer also receives \$200. Other poster design finalists are also selected by grade category and honored at the Green Up Awards Dinner in Montpelier in late March. The Governor, when possible, presents the honors.

GUIDELINES

Any entries not adhering to the following will be disqualified.

- ↪ Must include the words **Green Up Vermont**
- ↪ Size **11" X 14" PORTRAIT** (vertical orientation only)
- ↪ Must NOT include brand names or logos
- ↪ Original "free-hand" work only (no computers)
- ↪ Entry information must be on back, upper right corner
- ↪ Open to all students K-12 -- one entry per student

ADVICE

- ↪ Lettering should be clear, easy-to-read
- ↪ Successful viewing from a distance (avoid tiny detail)
- ↪ Be colorful and neat (pastels/pencils not the best)
- ↪ Avoid global images
- ↪ Avoid feature on recycling (Green Up is clean up)
